






Chair's Introduction

As school attempted to return to normal in Sept 21 after the disruptions of Covid-19 the PTFA continued to uphold our charities commitment to provide a link between home and school and to raise funds along the way to enhance the learning experience of Tallis pupils.

Our 21/22 fundraising came from a wonderful spread of campaigns and events.

We are very proud to have raised in the region of £6000 in the 21/22 year and as I step down after 7 years of being Chair I am excited and proud to be handing over to an amazing team who are seamlessly taking on the continuation of existing campaigns and the planning and preparation of new ideas and events to continue to support Tallis in every way possible.



Tech for Tallis

This campaign, set up in April 2019 to support many of our pupils affected by limited or no access to Technology at home during Covid, continues to exist but changed its focus in 21-22 to be just a fundraising scheme with the collection/distribution of refurbished items being paused. Donations were still coming in during 21/22 but slowed down as no targeted fund-raising was actioned as the need for the scheme changed.

The PTFA and the School are aware that a new direction for Tech For Tallis needs to be forged so we can continue to help those in need as each new Yr 7 Cohort joins Tallis.

- Since April 2019 the total raised to date is £9,513
- 30 + Second hand devices have been refurbished and passed on to students
- 48 NEW laptops have been purchased using PTFA funds and loaned to students
- New plans to support students with on going IT needs at home is on the agenda between School and the PTFA and your donations are needed as much as ever.

Pre-loved Uniform

We continue our commitment to Reduce, Reuse & Recycle made in the 2018/19 AGM by keeping as much uniform out of landfill as we can. We sell 2nd hand uniform at school events and it can also be accessed by pupils and staff via reception should any emergency uniform be required.

These are being sold as NEW (at reduced cost) at our 2nd hand sale events and the PTFA have also gifted stock to school who give them to students who qualify for assistance with the cost of uniform.






