Year 12 Mock Examinations – Tuesday 18th April to Thursday 27th April 2017

Attached to this letter you will find a copy of the Year 12 Mock Examination Timetable. All mock examinations will be sat in the Main Hall or Sports Hall, unless alternative arrangements are in place, and will follow strict examination rules and regulations.

Students will be required to be in school during the mock examination week, either sitting their exams or attending normal timetabled lessons.

Please have a look at the timetable with your child and ensure that they are prepared for each examination. The minimum equipment required for each examination is as follows:

- A black ink pen and a spare
- A calculator, pencil, ruler, rubber if the paper/subject requires one
- A clear pencil case for the above

They can bring a bottle of water into the examination, but the wrapper will need to be removed. No other items are allowed into the examination venue.

The mock examinations will be run as if they were the student's real examinations and therefore it is good practice to get into the habit of what is required. The majority of the students are following two-year linear courses; therefore these examinations will be used as a thermometer to see how well they are progressing towards their final examinations in Summer 2018. Their achievement within this set of examinations may lead to further conversations about their future. We need all students to take these examinations seriously and give 100% effort.
