



Advice for visitors to our school – Covid 19

The safety of our community continues to be our top priority. As we have done through the pandemic, we will continue to follow Government and Public Health guidance.

What you need to do if you visit our school:

- To help reduce the spread of Covid-19, we are asking visitors to take a lateral flow test before arrival. Please only continue with your visit if the result is negative. [Tests can be obtained from various local locations.](#)
- Please do not come to our school if you are displaying any Covid 19 symptoms.
- Please do not come to our school if you have been advised to isolate by NHS Test and Trace.
- We would be happy if you wear a face mask while on site, and particularly in high traffic areas like corridors, unless you are exempt. You can grab a face mask from reception.
- Please respect other people's decision to wear a face covering and, if possible, please wear one if someone else is uncomfortable.
- Make use of the hand sanitisers available, there is one at main reception and others dotted around or ask to use the toilets so you can wash your hands with soap and water.
- Be mindful of social distancing wherever possible.
- We are strongly encouraging our staff and students to get vaccinated and would like to pass this sentiment on to all our visitors.
