

Independent Learning - Advice for Teachers

- 1) Think carefully about the tasks you are setting your classes. Make sure your expectations are clear and reasonable and any work set is accessible for all of your students
- It is best if teachers set standardised work as a faculty to keep up consistency. Please speak to your Curriculum Leader for more details
- 3) Try not to set random, unconnected activities. There should be a clear purpose and sequence to the work that is set
- 4) Use Insight to set work in the first instance. You may use this to direct students to other platforms that can be used, such as Microsoft Teams, MyMaths and Google classroom
- 5) Try and check in with students regularly: answer emails within 24 hours and update Insight every week (if you are not well enough to do this, please contact your Curriculum Leader)
- 6) Give praise and encouragement to any students who send you work or contact you. Keep awarding positive points on PARs.
- If you have any concerns about students not completing work, please contact parents via email or Insight
