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Dear Parents and Carers

We are writing to you with further information about arrangements for your year 10 child's learning over the rest of this term. We hope you find this helpful.

Remote assessments

Thank you for your support with the Year 10 remote assessments this week. We know that this has been a different experience for students, and that some of the timings have not been ideal, but we hope that they have not found the experience to be too challenging.

Targeted onsite provision for some students

As we are still unfortunately unable to welcome all of year 10 on site, we have planned some targeted onsite provision for some year 10 students. We have identified a cohort of students who we think will most benefit from additional support between now and the end of term. If your child is in one of these groups, we have written to you separately.

Increased remote learning

For everyone else in year 10, we are aiming to increase our remote teaching timetable for the last two weeks of term, so that Year 10 students will have a full timetable of lessons over that period, as well as sending out further revision materials for use over the summer. We will aim to offer a full timetable of remote lessons from Monday 6 July until Thursday 16 July. This is to support students as fully as possible in advance of their return in September. Continuing to do this remotely will be far more efficient than bringing students in to school in small groups.

Teaching clashes

Please note, however, that some teachers will be unable to deliver some year 10 lessons. This may be because of

- staff being required on site to support students in years 7, 8 and 9,
- staff being on site providing targeted support for some year 10 students
- our ongoing supervision of vulnerable and key worker children onsite,
- end of term online celebration assemblies (The Year 10 Celebration Assembly is on Monday 13 July, at 2pm)

Teachers will notify students when this is the case and make alternative arrangements.

Revision packs

We will be posting home packs of additional revision material from most subjects for students to make use of over the summer break. We will also include additional guidance materials to support students' use of these materials.

End of year progress reports

We will issue end of year reports for year 10 during the last week of term. These will include end of course predictions for your child's courses, as well as written comments in relation to their progress.
