**Year 11 Spring Mock Examinations and In Class Assessments:  
Monday 23 February – Tuesday 10 March 2026**

Attached, you will find a copy of the Year 11 Spring Mock Examination Timetable.

The English, maths, science and Latin mock examinations will be sat in the Sports Hall or, if your child has specific exam dispensation, an agreed alternative venue. For all other options subjects, students will take in-class assessments during lesson time.

For all mocks and assessments, students are required to be in school as normal, in correct uniform.

**Examinations in the Sports Hall will start at 8:45am each day.** The arrangement for each day is outlined below:

Tutor/Assembly, 08:30	<b>08:30, meet in the Canteen 08:45, morning exams begin</b>
Period 2, 10:00-11:00	Return to lessons after morning exam has finished
Periods 3 to 6	Normal lessons, including the in-class mock assessment

Students need to bring the following to all exams:

- A calculator, which is required for Maths and Science exams.  
**\*Please note that the school does not provide calculators for exams.**
- A clear pencil case
- A black ink pen
- A pencil
- A ruler
- A rubber

Bottles of water should have labels removed.

Phones and smart watches must be off and in students' bags.


