Dear Parents and Carers

I am writing to let you know that in the week starting Monday 19 June, we will be setting Year 9 students mock Science exams in their lessons to assess their understanding of the GCSE Science courses so far. The assessment will consist of three exams in lesson time set separately on Biology, Chemistry and Physics. The class teachers will communicate the exact dates in the week leading up to the exams.

To support the students we will be revising in lessons after half term. However, it would be useful if the students did some revision at home using their revision guides. The relevant page numbers are:

Chemistry: Atomic Structure and Structure and Bonding p.8-29 and p.44-49 (practice questions)

Physics: Particle Model of Matter, Atomic Structure and Radioactivity p.84-93 and p.104-107 (questions)

Biology: Cells p.8-17 and Infectious Diseases p.34-41, p.56-60 and p.64-67 (questions)

Reading the relevant pages, and doing the questions on the page numbers above, is recommended.

The mock results, taken in conjunction with the tests the students have taken throughout the year, will be used to set them into Year 10.
